COLLECTION OF SURCHARGES AND TAXES ON BEHALF OF AIRLINES & GOVERNMENTS

From May 2004, airlines operating out of Singapore have implemented a fuel surcharge on air tickets issued for travel on their flights to combat the impact and cover the costs of the steep rise in the price of aviation fuel.

As an agent of the airlines, your NATAS travel agent is tasked to collect these fuel surcharges on the airlines' behalf when passengers book and issue the air tickets through the travel agent.

Customers are required to pay such surcharges and taxes including the fuel surcharge as informed by your NATAS travel agent. These monies are collected on behalf of government authorities and the airlines and are subject to change with or without notice.
